Coursework Deadlines

Students are expected to complete all course work by the deadline for the semester following the semester they are enrolled in the course. Students not completing the course by their deadline may request an extension if they made adequate progress in the course. Additionally, there are specific deadlines for the purpose of receiving credits and grade for a specific semester, which are important for graduation and GPA ranking purposes.

General Information

What is Garza High School Online?

Garza High School Online is an educational opportunity to obtain credits by working online to either recover or accelerate needed required courses.

Eligibility

- Students enrolled in Austin ISD in grades 8-12 may participate in this program beginning in the semester of their 8th grade year.
- Students must have written permission from their counselor and principal (or principal's designee) at their home campus.
- Applications are available from the student's counselor. Applications must be completed on the official application form for the current semester. Please note that the form requires both parts 1 and 2 typed, needs multiple signatures, and must be faxed directly from the student's counselor. Incomplete, or improperly submitted forms will not be accepted.

Things to Consider



• Do you have reliable access to a computer and the Internet?

You need to have regular unlimited access to a computer and the Internet. At a minimum, we recommend using a PC with Windows 7 or higher, or a Mac with OS X 10.6 or higher.

• Are you comfortable with computers and technology?

All courses use electronic files, email, web browsing, and word processing.

- **Does Garza HS Online affect UIL eligibility ("No Pass No Play")?**
Students shall adhere to the "No Pass No Play" procedures for online courses in accordance to district regulations and state law including providing progress reports to sponsors of extracurricular activities. Inadequate progress in Garza HS Online courses may affect UIL eligibility
- **Do you have the self-discipline to take an individualized paced course?**
Students should set goals and manage their time to complete their courses. To remain enrolled, students must make adequate academic progress.
- **Do you have enough time to complete a course online?**
Each course covers material in a regular full one semester course with multiple assignments, projects, and quizzes/exams. There are important deadlines if you need to complete a course for GPA ranking or graduation. Specific deadlines are listed on the back of this brochure.

Important information after enrollment

- Once the registration is complete, the student will receive an email confirmation with website and login information.
- Classes follow the instructional calendar for Garza HS. That means you can only begin or finish a course while Garza HS is in session.
- All coursework must be completed by deadline for the semester following the semester enrolled in the course. The deadlines are shown on the back of this guide. Students with adequate academic progress may request an extension in the course.
- If a student obtains credit through Garza HS Online for a course in which there is a STAAR EOC exam, the student must take the corresponding EOC exam at his or her campus and EOC guidelines apply.
- Check the syllabus for course specific policies including grading process, proctored coursework, and final exam prerequisites. Final exams will be proctored by a qualified AISD employee. To pass the course, students must earn a minimum grade of sixty percent (60%) on the final exam or project. Additional Information on our website.
- When exams are taken at Garza HS, students are required to have a school / photo ID.
